

The clients' desire to

create an escape from their busy days led them to the charm of this property. As plans for their dream house progressed, many challenges unfolded. Front yard tree conservancies, limited drive alignments and planting, and tight setbacks that waylaid plans for a pool.

After being brought into the middle of the project, damage control was performed, and the clients soon realized proper planning and landscaping would fulfill their dreams. Working with the city to develop a comprehensive plan, invasives were removed and landscaping plans were approved. The side-loaded drive leads to a front courtyard that edges the line of the conservancy. All work in this area was performed by hand. The existing turf was not removed, but was restored through slit seeding, per city approvals.

The pool wishes were soon transformed into plans for an elegant fountain with

bluestone patio recessed into the landscape. While furniture was chosen to accentuate the environment within the home, flower colors were selected to complement both the interior and exterior.
